NOTICE OF RACE LAKE WINNIPESAUKEE SAILING ASSOCIATION

Saturday, September 11 & Sunday, September 12, 2004

SITE: Lake Winnipesaukee, New Hampshire. Race headquarters, launch, and haul out will be at Fay's Boat Yard in Gilford, NH. The Barbecue will be at the Winnipesaukee Yacht Club. Racing will be on the main portion of Lake Winnipesaukee, 1.5 miles East of Fay's Boat Yard.

RULES: This regatta will be governed by the 2001-2004 *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the J80 class rules , this notice, and by the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all J/80 class yachts as defined by the class association. Competitors must meet all ownership, class membership and yacht measurement requirements and must have paid all dues and event fees before becoming official competitors. All competitors shall be weighed in prior to the first warning and each yacht's total crew weight shall not exceed the Class limit.

ENTRY FEES: The Entry Fee of \$75.00 includes Launching, Haul Out, Mooring, Beer at Launching and Haul Out, T-shirt and barbecue ticket for skipper. There is an additional charge of \$7.00 if the owner or skipper is not a member of the US Sailing Association. In order for us to provide enough Beer and Food, we request that all entries be received **as early as possible**. For this reason, there is a late registration fee of \$10.00 if received after Wednesday, Sept 1st.

NOTE: Early registration is requested. **The order of Haul Out on Sunday afternoon will based on the order of registrations received.** Final registration will close at 0930 on Saturday at Fay's Boat Yard in Gilford, NH.

RACING: The racing on Saturday will include as many races as we can run for both classes. Sunday's racing will be planned so that all boats will be **out of the water** by 1730.

SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System, as provided in Appendix A4 of the *Racing Rules of Sailing* will be used. A single race will constitute a regatta and all races will count.

PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded for the top four finishing places.
